TIGHTS AND BALLET SHOES

Children's Dance and Elementary Ballet 1-3 Students wear footed, non-shiny pink tights(or tights to match your skin tone if preferred) and pink leather full sole ballet shoes

Intermediate Ballet 1 through Advanced wear footed or convertible non-shiny pink tights (or tights to match skin tone if preferred). Convertible tights work best for Pre-pointe/Pointe classes. Tights must be clean and free of holes. Pink canvas or leather split sole ballet shoes with elastics criss-crossed and SEWN

OTHER CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Contemporary Classes	Any solid color leotard, black footless or stirrup tights
Boys in Children's Dance	Black biker shorts, snug-fitting white t-shirt, white socks and white ballet shoes
Boys/Men in Elementary Ballet 1 & up	Black tights, fitted solid t-shirt, white socks, white ballet shoes

GROOMING REQUIREMENTS

Creative Movement, Pre Ballet, Elementary Ballet 1 and all Contemporary classes: Female students must be well groomed with their hair pulled back from their faces. Short hair may be managed with a headband, clips, etc.

Elementary Ballet 3 through Advanced, Teen/Adult: Female students should wear their hair in a traditional bun. NO BANGS.

Watches and Jewelry (except for small stud earrings) are NOT allowed in class. This includes rings, necklaces, bracelets, lip/nose rings.
