Tell your kids about the session well ahead of time. Tell them what to expect. Let them know how much you're looking forward to it and why your family is doing it. If you're excited, they'll definitely catch your enthusiasm!

LET THEM BE INVOLVED

Include your children in the planning process. Ask them what colors they think the family should wear. Help them think of a fun pose to try. When children feel involved, they're much more willing to participate.

BRING BACKUP

Make sure you're well prepared for your session day. Bring along a change of clothes, plenty of snacks, water, diapers, etc. That way, even if the unexpected happens, you'll be ready for it!

MAKE IT FUN!

Make the day a special occasion! Bring along snacks and toys to keep their energy up. Plan on doing something fun after the session so they look forward to the outing all day.

best times for your family portrait session

When is the best time to have your family portrait session? Timing is always important to consider when it comes to photography, especially when children are involved. Lighting and time of day are important considerations for Jeni when planning your session, but if the time suggested conflicts with your normal schedule that is something to consider and discuss.

TARTICIPATION

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AFTER A MEAL

Make sure children (and adults!) are well-fed before your session. If they're hungry, they might start to get a little antsy and cranky. If you're planning on going to dinner afterwards, give your kids a healthy snack before the session and pack along a few extra snacks just in case.

WHENEVER YOUR KIDS ARE WELL-RESTED

Nothing makes kids grouchy and uncooperative like being tired. Be sure that your family session doesn't interrupt any of your kids' naptime or bedtime routines.



The meeting location will be emailed to you with confirmation of your date and time.

We will do everything we can to ensure there will be no conflicts, however Idaho weather is unpredictable, and outdoor locations are always first come first serve. If weather is an issue we will contact you and you will have the choice of an indoor studio session or an alternate date/time when weather permits.

tips on: what to wear



When it comes to family portraits, one of the most common questions we get is, "What should we wear?" It's a tricky decision! Since these portraits will last a lifetime, you want to make sure your entire family looks as good as possible. But at the same time, you also want them to look like themselves – not wearing stuffy clothes that make them feel uncomfortable. We always recommend wearing clothing that makes you feel and look your best, which can be different for every person. Here are a few other wardrobe suggestions that photograph beautifully.

WEAR COORDINATING (NOT MATCHING) OUTFITS

Make sure your outfits coordinate well with one another. Stick to a color palette of one or two colors. Matching outfits can look a little dated – coordinated outfits look harmonious and pretty. To make sure all of your outfits go well together, try laying out everyone's photoshoot outfits together the day before.

BRING FOCUS TO YOUR FACE

The best way to bring focus to your face is to keep colors in harmony and choose outfits with long or 3/4 sleeves. Work with a color scheme that looks good with your complexion. Avoid high contrast colors. (Meaning extreme dark paired with extreme light)

DRESS WEATHER APPROPRIATE

Keep an eye on the weather forecast and make sure you dress accordingly. Choose colors that are appropriate for the season. And if it'll be chilly during your session, be sure to bundle up a bit!

A FEW DON'TS:

While what you decide to wear is ultimately up to you and your family, there are a few things that tend not to photograph well.

• Patterns: one or two family members wearing a pattern is okay, but too many patterns or small multicolor plaids tend to clash and draw too much attention.

- White: Everyone wearing white works, only one wearing white tends to wash people out, the brightest color is what your eye will be drawn to.
- Large logos: graphic tees tend to distract from the most important part of the photo your beautiful faces!
- Glitter/highlighter: Makeup with a high shimmer or glitter does not photograph nice, it will look like white specs, so choose makeup carefully.
